



Mainland, Macao and overseas philatelic products on sale at ShopThruPost from 29 July 2021

Selected philatelic products issued by Mainland, Macao and overseas postal administrations, including Australia, Isle of Man, Japan, Liechtenstein, New Zealand, the United Kingdom and the United Nations will be **put on sale on the Hongkong Post Online Shopping Mall - "ShopThruPost" (shopthrupost.hongkongpost.hk) starting from 8 am of 29 July 2021.**

Stamp enthusiasts and Pokémon fans will surely crave for the limited-edition stamps on Pokémon issued by Japan Post. In celebration of Pokémon's 25th anniversary, Japan Post collaborates with the Pokémon Company to issue a collection of two Pokémon-themed souvenir sheets featuring the classic Pokémon trading cards of first-generation Pokémon such as Pikachu, Eevee, Magikarp, Mewtwo and the colourful illustrations of Pokémons playing together in different scenes across the four seasons. Each design of the souvenir sheets has a limited stock of 1000 sheets. A maximum of two souvenir sheets of each design can be purchased in each transaction on a first-come, first-served basis while stocks last.

Issued by Liechtensteinische Post AG, the Olympics souvenir sheet adopts the style of manga, Japanese comics, in the design. 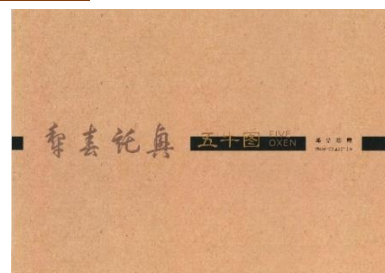

Year of Xinchou	2021 marks the Year of Xinchou in the Lunar Calendar. The zodiac Ox represents strength and spirit and it serves as a symbol of “keeping feet on the ground, pursuing the can-do spirit, pioneering and pushing ahead and staying diligent and dedicated. The “Year of the Ox” presentation pack is a traditional Chinese zodiac product of the China National Philatelic Corporation and it comes with a protective cover containing a block of four “Year of Xinchou” stamps, making it suitable for collection.

Five Buffaloes	This presentation pack took the idea of “best wishes for spring ploughing” from the annotation of Five Buffalos as the main design concept. The pack is made of kraft paper and the cover is printed with the only forward striding buffalo from the Five Buffalos, which is also the only coloured buffalo. The cultural essence of the Five buffalos is shown through these details.

Libraries in Macao II	In 2019, there were 314 public libraries and reading rooms in Macao, with the highest density among the neighbouring regions. The public libraries are mainly operated by the Cultural Affairs Bureau, Education and Youth Development Bureau, Municipal Affairs Bureau and other government departments, as well as churches, private institutions and associations. A total of 18 libraries managed by the Cultural Affairs Bureau are located in the World Heritage sites, parks, markets, squares and waterfront, etc. These libraries, like the learning oasis in such a busy city, not only let readers enjoy the pleasure of reading but also lift up their spirit, because most of their designs integrate with the nature and surrounding environment. The stamp issue “Libraries in Macao II” leads us to visit five distinctive libraries.

Procession of Our Lady of Fatima	Every year, on 13 May, the Catholic Church celebrates the veneration of Our Lady of Fatima, in memory of the apparition of Our Lady to three little shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal, on 13 May 1917. Our Lady asked the world to recite the Rosary daily for the repentance of sinners and peace in the world. The “Feast and Novena of Our Lady of Fatima” in Macao was first celebrated in 1929, and the “Procession of Our Lady of Fatima” was inscribed on the List of Intangible Cultural Heritage of Macao in 2019. With the reverence and enthusiasm of the Diocese of Macao for the veneration of Our Lady of Fatima, it is an important event not only for the Diocese of Macao, but also for Macao. Every year, many citizens and overseas Catholics come together in Macao to participate in this event.

Festivals – Buddha’s Birthday	Siddhartha Gautama, the founder of Buddhism, was born in 565 BC and he reached Nirvana (a place of perfect peace and happiness) in 486 BC. His honorific title is Buddha Shakyamuni. He was the son of King Suddhodana of Kapilavastu, which was located in the north of the ancient India. The Macao painter Sou Farong has created a set of stamps in the form of oil paintings to dedicate to the birth and the process of enlightenment of Buddha Shakyamuni. The color selection is quite a combination of Macao characteristics and the unique style commonly used in Tibetan Thangkas, representing an auspicious and festive atmosphere. Coupled with clear themes and rich imaginations, the vivid cartoonish characters will surely make the stamps very popular. The creation is not only a reflection of Buddhist doctrines, but also a very highly-artistic masterpiece.

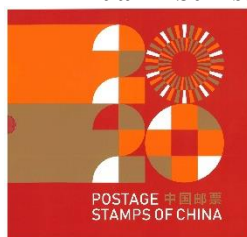

The issue title is an extract from the Queen's speech during her first overseas tour in 1947. Addressing the Commonwealth on her 21st birthday, the Queen said: "I declare before you all that my whole life, whether it be long or short, shall be devoted to your service and the service of our great imperial family to which we all belong."
